COMMERCIAL LITIGATION ISSUES OF INTEREST

August 2017

Your client, a Brazilian investment company authorized to do business in New York, purchased millions of dollars of bonds from an international bank with offices globally and in New York. You commenced a lawsuit in Supreme Court, New York County, against the bank's Swiss, Brazilian, and New York subsidiaries, to compel delivery of the bonds, which were purchased by your Brazilian client in Brazil. You claim the court has personal jurisdiction over the bank's Swiss and Brazilian subsidiaries under the long-arm statute. You allege that the bank's entities are actually one corporation with an interactive website that advertises to consumers, including New Yorkers, and allows consumers to apply for the bank's services online. Will you defeat the motion to dismiss made by the foreign defendants?

The answer is no.

In Cragnotti and Partners Capital Investment-Brazil S.A. v. Quintella, 650075/2015, NYLJ 1202781884008, at *1, (Sup. Ct. N.Y. Co. February 23, 2017), Cragnotti, a Brazilian investment company authorized to do business in New York, sued Credit Suisse's entities domiciled in Switzerland, Brazil, and New York for fraud and to compel the delivery of \$193 million of Argentinian bonds purchased by Cragnotti in Brazil from Credit Suisse's Brazilian predecessor. All defendants moved to dismiss for forum non conveniens The foreign defendants moved to dismiss for lack of personal jurisdiction.

Cragnotti argued for personal jurisdiction over the foreign defendants under CPLR 301(a)(1) and (4), (the long-arm statute), alleging that Credit Suisse's entities were actually one corporation, which operated an interactive website that advertised to customers, including New Yorkers, and allowed consumers to apply for Credit Suisse's services. Cragnotti also argued that Credit Suisse owned unspecified real property in New York, subjecting the foreign defendants to personal jurisdiction in New York.

The Court rejected Cragnotti's argument under CPLR 302(a)(1), citing *Wiison v. Dantas*, 128 A.D.3d 176, 181 (1st Dep't. 2015). The Court explained that two elements must be satisfied – the defendant must transact business in New York, and the plaintiff's cause of action must arise from that transaction. Additionally, there must be minimal contacts with New York to comport with due process.

The Court ruled that mere solicitation of business in New York does not constitute the transaction of business within the state unless it is supplemented by transactions in the state, citing *O'Brien v. Hackensack Univ. Med. Ctr.*, 305 A.D.2d 199, 201 (1st Dep't 2003). Moreover, maintaining a globally-accessible website does not constitute the transaction of business in New York, unless the website specifically targets its activities at New York, as ruled in *Kejriwal v. UCO Bank*, No. 12-CV-7507, 2014 WL 116218 (S.D.N.Y. Jan.10, 2014).

Cragnotti's claims met none of these criteria. The purchase was made in Brazil and not on the website. The Court explained that an interactive website, without more, does not support jurisdiction, because the constitutional underpinnings of New York's long-arm statute require something more, citing *Capital Records, LLC v. VideoEgg, Inc.* 611 F.Supp 2d 3409, 358 (S.D.N.Y. 2009).

The Court also rejected Cragnotti's claim of personal jurisdiction under CPLR 302(a)(4), which extends long-arm jurisdiction to a defendant who owns or possesses real property in New York State, because the required connection between the causes of action and the real property was missing, citing *CDR Creances S.A.S. v. First Hotels & Resorts Investments, Inc.*, 140 A.D.3d 558, 563 (1st Dep't 2016).

The motion for dismissal under forum *non conveniens* was granted as to both the New York defendants and the foreign defendants.

The lesson? Whenever possible, clients who conduct transactions outside of New York should obtain a writing providing for jurisdiction of all disputes in New York. Solicitation of business on interactive websites of non-New York domiciliaries, without more, will not constitute transacting business to support jurisdiction in New York.
