IN ROCKLAND COUNTY**

*(New City, New York, October 5, 2017)*...For the first time in recent history, four Justices of the Supreme Court of the State of New York Appellate Division, Second Department, will hear Oral Arguments in both Civil and Criminal Appeals at the Rockland County Court House on October 10, 2017.

In order to better serve their constituents, the Justices will travel to Rockland County to hold one of its two October 10<sup>th</sup> sittings. Associate Justice Mark C. Dillon will preside over the sitting and be joined on the bench by Associate Justices Jeffrey A. Cohen, Francesca E. Connolly and Linda Christopher, all of the Ninth Judicial District. The Appellate Proceedings will take place from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in Ceremonial Courtroom 2.

Prior to the Proceedings, the Justices will hold a “Meet and Greet” with members of the Bench and Bar at the Rockland County Courthouse, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, New Wing, Courtroom #9, Room #453 from 9:15 a.m. to 9:45 a.m.. Refreshments will be served.
