SPECIAL MASTER KENNETH FEINBERG

ADDRESSES ROCKLAND BAR ASSOCIATION

Kenneth Feinberg, the Special Master appointed by Presidents and Judges to award compensation to the victims of the 9/11 Attacks, the BP Gulf Oil Spill, the Virginia Tech, Sandy Hook and Aurora, Colorado shootings, the Boston Marathon bombing, the Volkswagen recall and the victims of the recent tragic shootings in Orlando, addressed the members of the Rockland County Bar Association on Thursday, September 8, 2016 at Italiana's restaurant in New City.

A graduate of New York University Law School and a former federal prosecutor, Mr. Mr. Feinberg is the Boston born attorney who once served as chief of staff to Senator Ted Kennedy and who time and again has been called upon to decide how victims of many of our nation's most high profile tragedies are to be compensated.

Mr. Feinberg addressed members of the Rockland County Bar Association on the topic of "Unconventional Responses to Unique Catastrophes: Tailoring the Law to Meet the Challenges."
